Our Guest Speaker at the December 19th meeting was Andy Kwak, currently Executive Director, Community and Family Services, Salvation Army, Edmonton Area. He was formally introduced by Chuck Gerhart.

Andy hails from **Holland** where his parents both were members of the Salvation Army.

He himself has now served with the S. Army for 20 years, and has been involved in a variety of missions overseas, pertaining to *Disaster Relief* a period in **Kosovo** where he worked with the **U.N** assisting with refugee requirements.

In **Chechnya**, where he served under difficult circumstances being treated with suspicion by local authorities and on at least one occasion actually came under hostile fire.

In **Malawi** he worked on a food program distributing food to orphans and the poor and destitute.

He also worked at **Ground Zero** in **New York City** following 9/11, in **Mississippi** on Hurricane relief and various floods in the **U.S** and **Canada**.

He now serves in **Edmonton** with family and social services, where for example the **S.Army** operates a "crisis line" geared towards suicide prevention and organized to enable teens to call in and talk to other teens re their problems.

A regular Friday morning breakfast program which caters to between 150/200 people.

A children's camp at Pine Lake which accommodates up to 120 children each summer.

These and other programs operate from a budget of some \$750,000 which is all raised from donations through the **Christmas Kettles** and **Red Shield** appeals, no **Government** support is provided.

A number of interesting questions were answered by **Andy** following which he was thanked on behalf of the Club by **Marty Larson**, and presented him with a Club gift.

Andy was asked to make the **Free Lunch** draw, the result of which was **Bob Berube** being declared the lucky winner.
