**Remi** began his presentation by stating that he specializes in **Death** and **Taxes** and provided the founding principles of his **Intestate Will 2012**.

The Prudent Investor Rule utilizes 20/20 Hindsight

The Will I have if I don't have a Will is not worth the paper it's not written on Not one of us will leave this world alive!

Remi also advised that the only way to avoid estate fees and taxes is by stating the following nine words:

I, am being of sound mind, spent it all.

Without a Will, decisions about your estate will be made by the government and the courts. You will be subject to Capital Gain on the deemed proceeds of the assets as well as 5% GST. In Canada, you have the right to control or limit medical treatment but not the right to decide on life or death. Think about what will happen down the line and minimize the tax consequences. The typical cost of a will if you include a Personal Directive and an Enduring Power of Attorney is \$1000. The maximum probate fee in Alberta is \$400.
